Living the Missional Life: (Acts 17:16-34)

1. Burden for those far from Jesus (16)
2. Cultural engagement (17)
3. Authentic lifestyle (18)
4. Courage for divine opportunities (19-21)
5. Relational interaction (22-23)
6. Unashamed gospel story (24-31)
7. Faith in God's sovereignty (32-34)

Empowered to Live the Missional Life: (2 Tim 1)

1. You have been given a GIFT (6)
2. Your gift is wrapped with COURAGE (7)
3. Your gift has come with POWER (7; Eph 3:6ff)
4. Your gift in power is rooted in GOD (8)
5. Your gift has been given by GRACE (9)
6. Your gift has been given for His PURPOSE (9)
7. Your gift is empowered by the HOLY SPIRIT (14)

The Daily Realities of Living the Missional Life:

1. The lifestyle demands the POWER of God (1)
2. The medium is YOUR story rooted in HIS story (2)
3. The medium is realized through RELATIONSHIP (3)
4. The lifestyle is ACTIVE and COMPETITIVE (4-7)
5. The lifestyle demands DISCIPLINE (4-7)
6. The lifestyle is REWARDING (5-7)
7. The lifestyle and medium are grounded in the MODEL (8-11)

Reflection:

Are you involved in the kind of relationship with Him where you feel strengthened and empowered by Him?

Can you tell your God story? Who are you telling? Whom haven't you told?

When you reflect on how a soldier fights, an athlete competes, or a hard working farmer farms, how does your life on mission with Christ compare?

Do you engage in this calling of living the missional life as if there is something to be gained or lost? (vs. 5-6, the athlete's crown, the farmer's first share of the crops)
